A Back to Netball session designed for Mum's with babies has been set up at Clissold Leisure Centre in Stoke Newington.

Great fun is being had with the Mum's playing netball and each rotating in and out to entertain the babies in turn.

'I was originally approached by Lizzy Silverton, a new Mum and blogger who's also trains to run marathons. Lizzy was inspired to restart her netball journey after listening to a fitness podcast that happened to feature Sasha and Kadeen Corbin talking about playing for England. Lizzy wanted to get herself and other Mums involved in Back to Netball where baby could come along too.



After a brief meeting in a local coffee shop in North London, the idea of a Back to Netball session for Mums, and their babies, was born! A few weeks later, the first session took place at Clissold Leisure Centre with our first group of Mums. Like many participants, there were a few anxious faces but once babies were settled and we played a few silly games to relax, the session got off to a cracking start. 60 minutes later and a little more sweaty and breathless than when we started, our inaugural session was finished with lots of smiling faces and a resolve to return.
